Herndon has been collaborating with Comstock, on transforming about 4.7 acres of its downtown area into a mixed-use development since Oct. 24, 2017, when the Herndon Town Council approved a comprehensive agreement between the two parties. However, the project hit a setback in July when the town received appeals from three citizens challenging the Herndon Heritage Preservation Review Board's June 18 decision to award Comstock three certificates of appropriateness, which are required for most exterior changes to buildings and structures within the town's heritage district.

HomeAid Northern Virginia

HomeAid Northern Virginia, Builder Captain Winchester Homes and 29 trade partners celebrated the completion of the renovated and expanded "Karen's Home" in Fairfax County, owned by Final Salute, Inc., the only non-profit organization in the D.C. metro area that offers housing



assistance exclusively to women veterans and their children who are experiencing homelessness. The \$650,000 project, of which 85 percent was donated, provides 8,700 sq. ft. of living space and converted the home's original seven bedrooms and five bathrooms to eight bedrooms and eight bathrooms. The entire interior and exterior were renovated and brought up to code, including new windows, flooring, termite remediation and repair, plumbing and electrical work, expanded storage, new appliances, kitchen and bath upgrades, new fixtures, and paint throughout the interior. Outside renovations included all-new siding, a deck, pergola, and landscaping. The entire home was

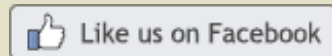
